Studii şi cercetări lingvistice has come out uninterruptedly since 1950. In the 1950-1998 span, there have been six issues per year, whereas in since 1999 the journal has had two issues per year.

Chronologically, the editors-in-chief of *Studii şi cercetări lingvistice* have been: V. Cheresteşiu (1950-1953), E. Petrovici (1954-1957), Al. Rosetti (1958-1971), I. Coteanu (1971-1998). Since 1999, editor-in-chief has been Marius Sala, Vice-President of Romanian Academy, director of "Iorgu Iordan – Al. Rosetti" Institute of Linguistics, while deputy editor-in-chief has been Ioana Vintilă-Rădulescu. Ever since 2000, *Studii şi cercetări lingvistice* has also had an international board of editors, whose members ensure the publication of high quality articles, in compliance with international standards.
